The home school counselor needs to request the course for the student using the **Genius** registration system <https://registration.ccsdde.net>.

Can a fee waiver be utilized for a CSN dual credit course? No. Fee waivers can only be utilized for standard CCSD/NVLA courses offered for \$50.00 per half credit.

Who can take a CSN dual credit course with NVLA? CSN dual credit courses at NVLA are open to all current junior and senior students wanting to obtain college credit while completing select high school courses.

What are the requirements for enrollment into a CSN dual credit course at NVLA?

- English courses – ACT score of 18 in English or higher
- Math 126 – ACT score between 22-24
- Math 127 – ACT score between 25-27

What if a student has not taken the ACT test yet? Students may take a FREE placement exam (Accuplacer) which is required ONLY for the Math and English courses (A reading placement exam is also required to be eligible to enroll into an English class). The FREE placement exam is scheduled to be given at Nevada Learning Academy on Saturday, May 16, 2015, at 10:00AM. Students must RSVP by 4:00PM Friday, May 15, 2015, to secure their seat for the exam.

How can students get a copy of their dual credit transcript? For more information, contact the office of the Registrar at CSN. Unofficial transcripts may be obtained, at no charge, if the student attended CSN the previous semester. Official transcripts cost \$2.00 in person. If ordered online there is an additional \$2.75 transaction fee.

Do all colleges and universities recognize dual credit earned? While CSN cannot guarantee the transfer of credits from concurrent enrollment courses, a survey conducted by the Western Interstate Commission on Higher Education (WICHE) shows that a majority of postsecondary institutions in the U.S. grant either elective or required credit for dual/concurrent enrollment courses. As with accelerated learning options, it is important for student to contact the university they are planning on attending.

Do students have to apply to CSN to take a dual credit course through NVLA? Yes. Students must complete the “MyCSN” online admissions application at www.csn.edu and the Concurrent Enrollment High School Authorization Form at www.csn.edu/jumpstart. Once the Concurrent Enrollment High School Authorization Form is completed and signed by all parties, fax the form to CSN Academic Partnerships (WCE254) Attention: Jumpstart Program at (702) 651-5938. When the admission is approved, students will receive an NSHE ID number and password via email.
