



George W. Turner Memorial Scholarship Application For Future Leaders

The George W. Turner Academic Scholarship Program is a \$1,000 merit scholarship for outstanding high school seniors. George W. Turner served the Moapa Valley as an educator for more than 30 years. He was dedicated to education and student success. In his memory, his family has instituted this scholarship for the benefit of extraordinary students.

DEADLINE: April 23, 2021

Eligibility requirements

To be considered for a George W. Turner Memorial Scholarship you must:

- Be accepted for enrollment at an eligible institution of higher education with a declared major.
- Expect to be a full-time freshman student enrolled at an eligible institution of higher education.
- Submit a letter of acceptance from the school or college with the application. (It does not have to be from the institution of your final choice.)
- Have a GPA of 3.50 or above on a 4.00 (unweighted) scale.

Applicants will be evaluated based on their academic success, extracurricular and service activities, and essay. This scholarship is intended for, although not limited to, students graduating from Moapa Valley High School. Candidates who are planning a career in education may also receive priority consideration.

Eligible Institutions

Eligible institutions include proprietary institutions of higher education and postsecondary vocational institutions, as well as public and private nonprofit institutions of higher education.

Scholarship Details

Scholarship awards are made without regard to race, creed, religious preferences, sex, or financial status. The scholarship amount is a one-time payment of \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollars) to the recipient to be used for college expenses. The scholarship may be held for up to 24 months for religious or civil service prior to college.

Deadlines

Scholarship application must be submitted to the MVEF Scholarship Coordinator, on or before _____.

Items that must be submitted with the application

- ___ Student application form (2 pages)
- ___ 500 word or less essay on the topic: "Why is education important for our entire society? What will you do to support education throughout your life?"
- ___ Official transcripts for grades 9 through mid-year of senior year
- ___ Evidence of acceptance from an institution of higher education (e.g. a printout of your acceptance email)
- ___ Personal resume, if desired, but not mandatory
