- III. Public Comment (3 minutes)- The Logandale Nevada Stake Organizations have some leftover funds that they are willing to donate to the high school to help pay for student fees etc. Erika Whitmore has the information.
- IV. MVHS Pandemic Issues/Discussion
  - A. Update 2020 Graduation- Hal received a guidance document today, completed it and sent it in to the Region, Dr. Mancil for approval. There has been no direction yet.

On Wednesday, May 20th, a stage will be set up in the circle for graduates to come and take a picture during the day- Social distancing guidelines will be followed during this process. They are encouraged to wear their graduation attire. No photographer will be provided at this time.

Proposed Drive in Graduation- Graduates will meet at Lin's and participate in a parade (under the direction of the Rotary Club). The parade route will be up Main Street to Cooper Street and on to Airport Road. Students will park in the senior parking lot, facing east. A small stage will accommodate a podium, with a microphone so the proceedings can be sent out via live stream to family members not in attendance and use an FM radio station for participants in vehicles. After a short speech by Valedictorians and the Salutatorian, Mr. Mortensen will speak, and the CCSD board member (dignitary) will recognize the class as graduates of 2020. Graduates will then drive out of the parking lot and into the circle where Mr. Mortensen will give them their diploma. A

photo will be taken of each student as they receive their diploma and they will receive a link so they can access the photos as desired.

B. 2020/2021 School Year Issues/Concerns- No direction has been given to date, although plans for distance learning are in the works on a district level. Discussion was had with regard to online learning and smaller class sizes, or rotating times of attendance. We are waiting on CCSD before we move forward in any direction.

V. Principal Report-

A. 2020/2021 Class Registration-.Information was mailed out and students were assigned a day to register for classes. Geniel said it went well.

B. Hal will see if there is any additional funding available for taking additional steps to “distance” students while at school.

C. Interviews for the Assistant Principal position will take place on Friday, May 8th. A Google meets link will be sent out to members of SOT.
